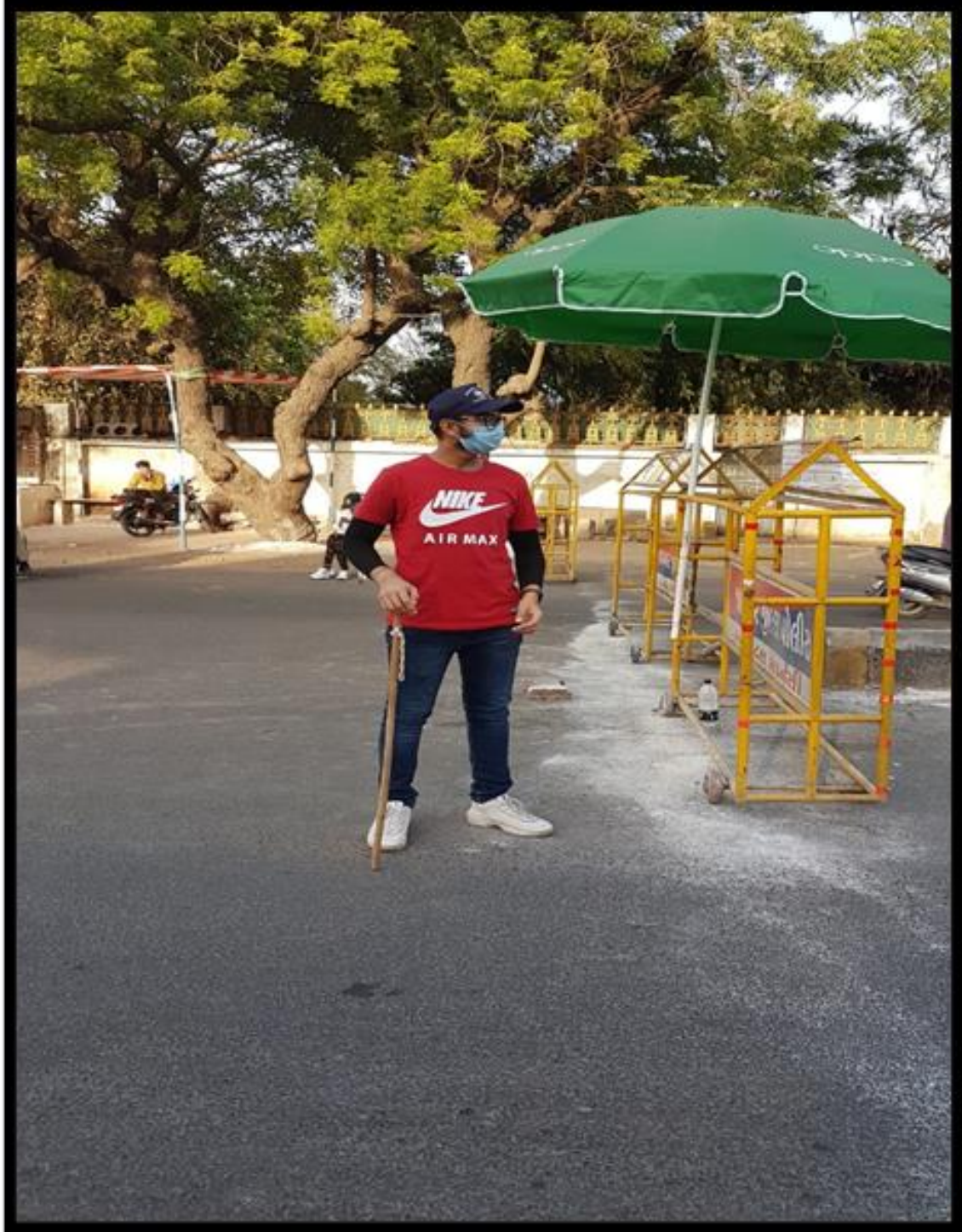

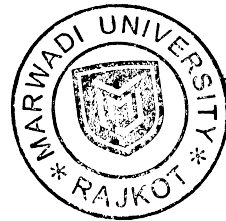

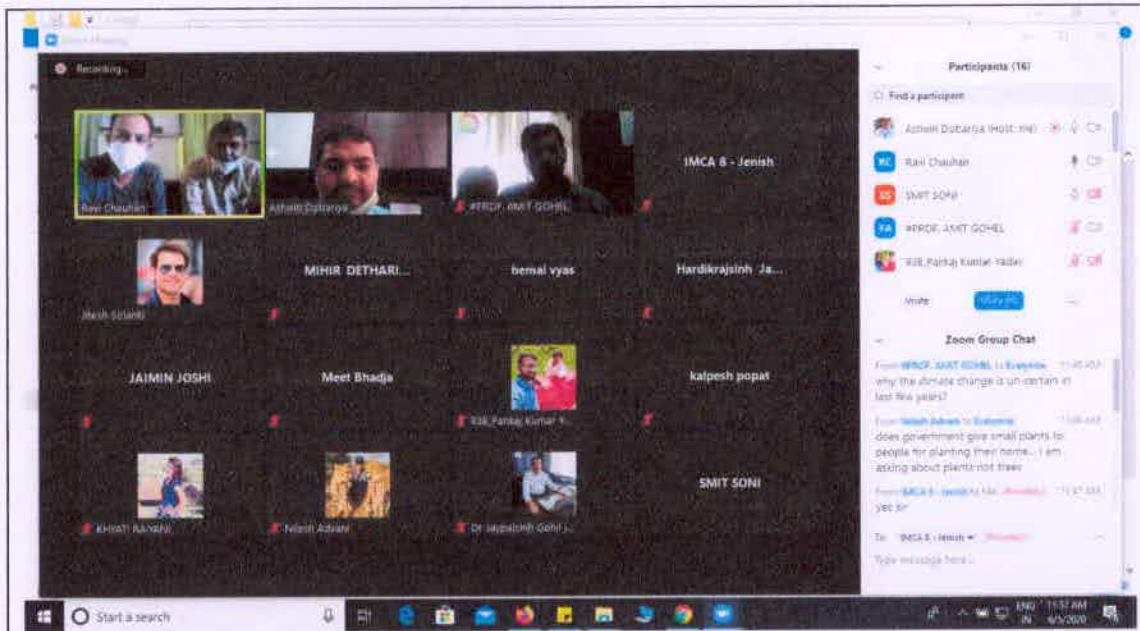
Webinar was started with welcome speech by Dr.Ashwin Dobariya, NSS Coordinator, FCA,MU and introduced both the experts.

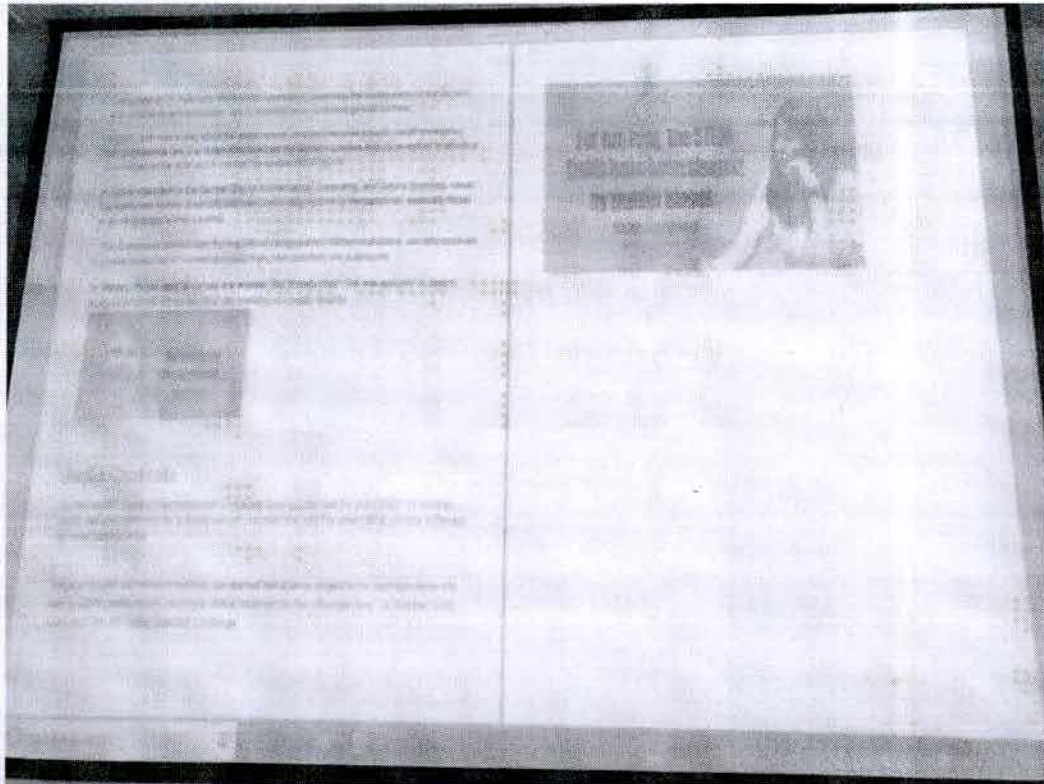
Description :

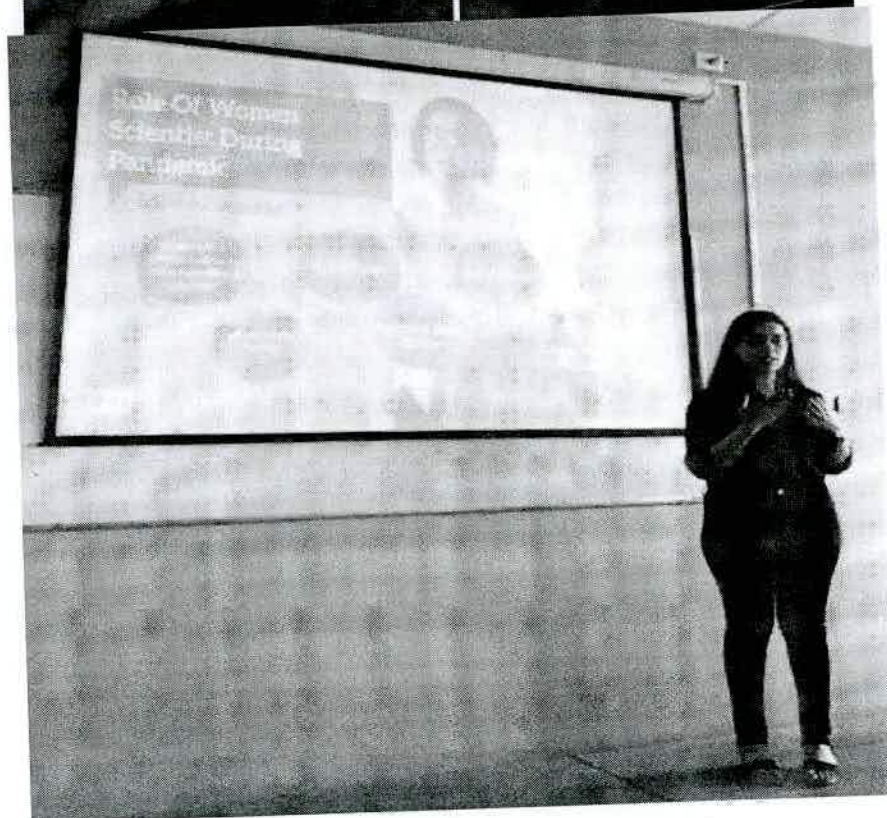
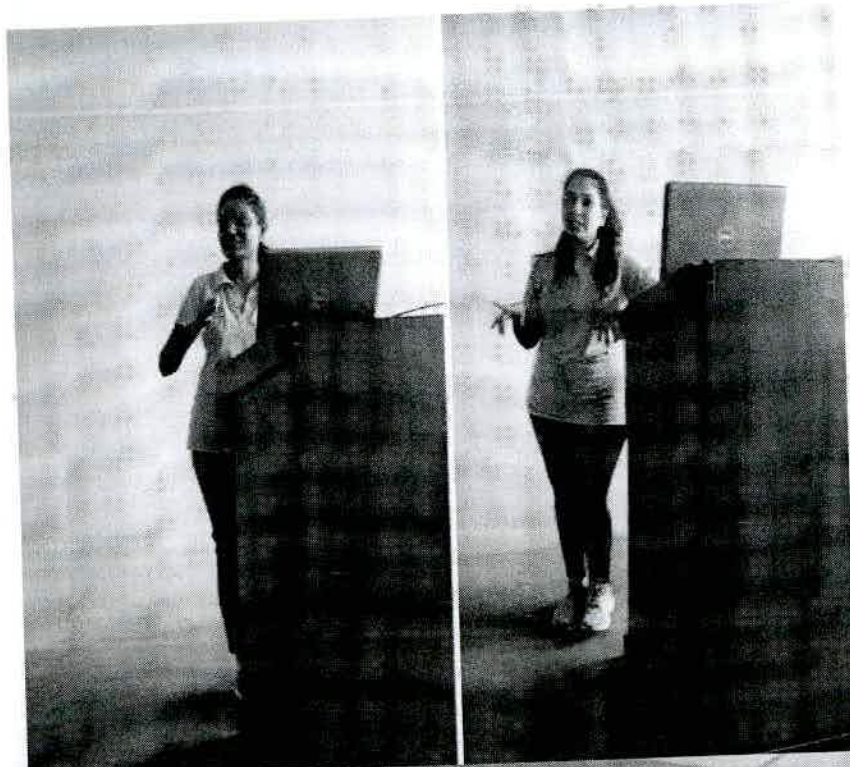

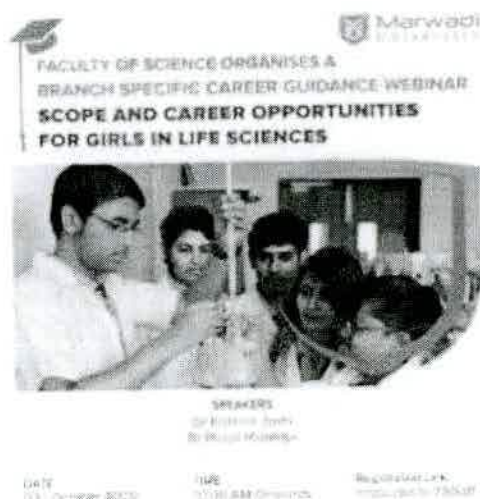

Report on the webinar:

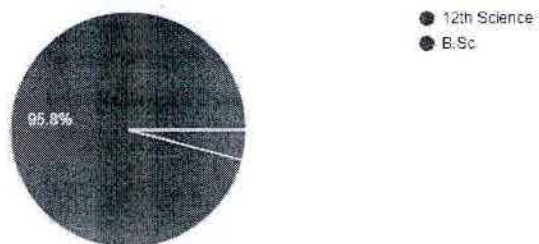
- › CGW was held on 3rd October, 2020.

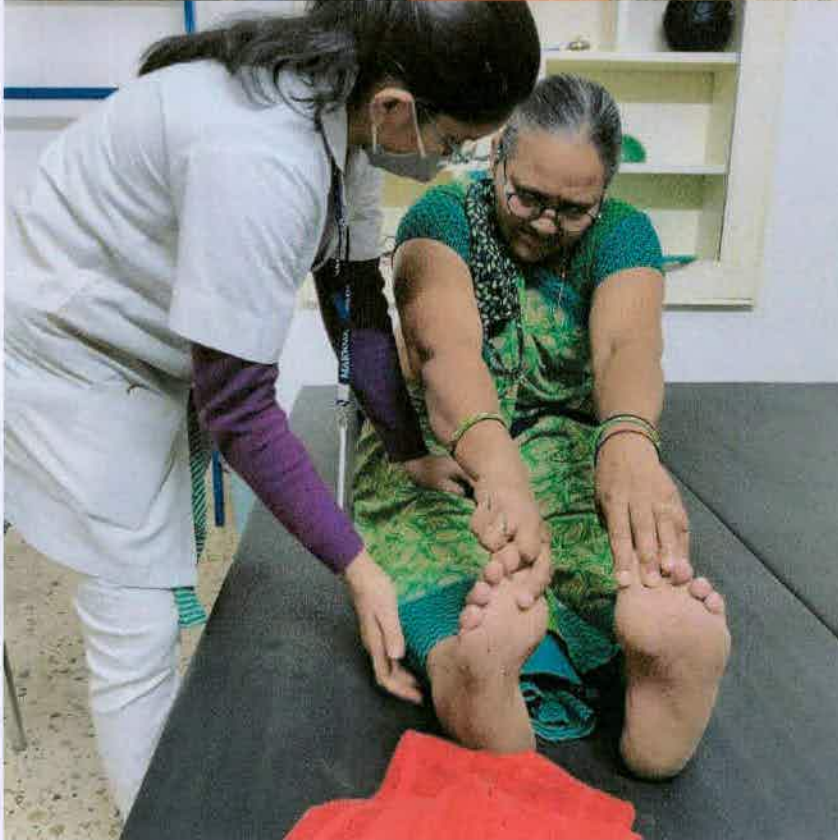
11 Students from SY BPT volunteered and helped in camp by teaching exercise to the patient as guided by therapists

Brief about ADR.

Adverse drug reactions (ADRs) have been reported to be among the leading causes of morbidity and mortality. The spontaneous reporting of ADRs is considered the foundation of post-marketing surveillance of drug safety. The main function of spontaneous reporting is the early detection of signals of new, rare and serious ADRs. It is also one of the cheapest methods of monitoring the safety of medicines as utilized by many drug regulatory agencies worldwide

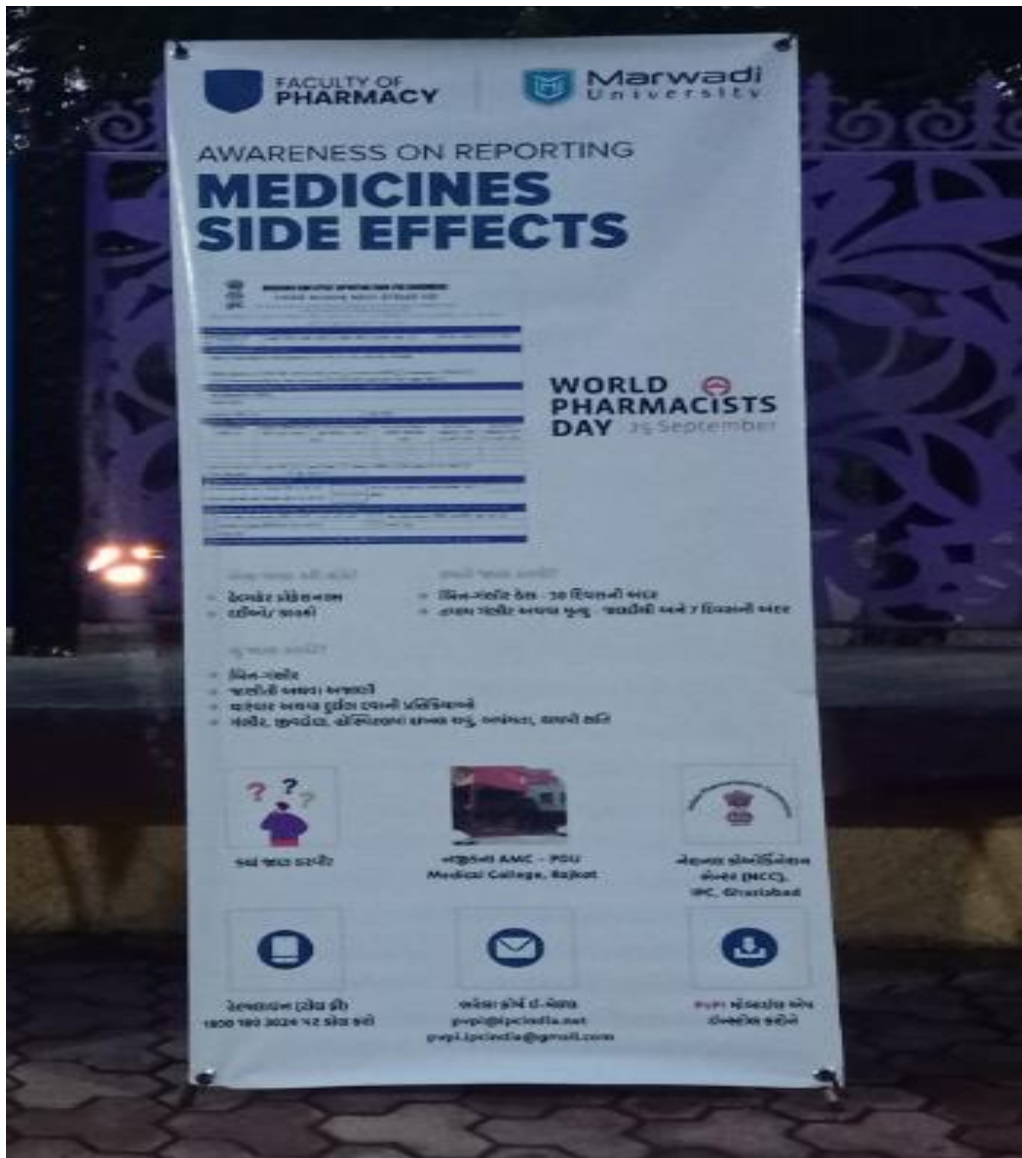
he primary care medical practitioners as well as the common public must be made aware of the importance and benefits of reporting adverse drug reactions (ADRs). The reporting of ADRs through periodic safety update reports is a regulatory requirement in many countries including India, however, the importance of ADR reporting through a spontaneous reporting system cannot be ignored. India has developed a robust PV system through the Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI) involving its various ADR Monitoring Centers and after the due quality check of Individual Case Safety Reports (ICSRs), submits this information to UMC through a web-based tool VigiFlow®. This information is then stored in VigiBase® which is the repository of worldwide ICSRs. Based on the drug safety information collected, PvPI issues alerts recommends label change (if any), and identifies signals thereby supporting National Regulatory Authority. At the national level, PvPI has developed several tools for reporting ADRs by the stakeholders.

This event was organized by the faculty of pharmacy at the race course ring road Rajkot. The mayor of the city visited the side and appreciated the work done at Marwadi University. During this event, general people who are coming for a morning walk took part in this drive. A total of 28 people have benefited from this event

Through this drive, department students also spread knowledge about glucose levels and also importance to maintain sugar levels in the body.

Aanganwadi and School Visit**Objective:**

The objective of the visit was to understand the functioning of an anganwadi and a primary school in a rural area in Devgam, near Rajkot, Gujarat and to interact with the children and the teachers.

Detailed Description

On 16th January 2021 a group of 224 college students visited Devgam in a group of 15 students in each group. Devgam is a small village near Rajkot in Gujarat. The group first visited the anganwadi center which caters to children between the ages of 0-6 years. The anganwadi worker showed the students the various facilities and services provided by the center such as providing nutritious food, health checkups, immunization, and preschool education. The students were impressed by the dedication of the anganwadi worker towards improving the health and well-being of the children in the village. They also interacted with some of the children and played with them.

Next, the group visited the primary school in the village. The school has a total of 70 students and three teachers. The group observed a classroom session where the students were being taught Mathematics by one of the teachers. They also interacted with the teachers and students and learned about the challenges faced by the school such as lack of infrastructure and shortage of teachers. The students were saddened to know that some of the students had to drop out of school due to financial reasons. The number of girl children who go to the school in this village is higher than the male children. Half of the group took the interview and the other half was involved in engaging the children. They conducted activities such as Dance and play games with the primary students of that school.

Health Care awareness:

The students spread awareness on health and hygiene, sanitation, body posture, personality, manners, good touch and bad touch, and boon and ban of Internet between primary students and school teachers the group was quite satisfied with the responses of the staff members and found them to be quite forthcoming.

Conclusion:

The village visit was a great learning experience for the college students as it helped them understand the challenges faced by rural communities in Gujarat and the role played by grassroots level initiatives such as anganwadi and schools in addressing them. The students were inspired by the dedication and commitment of the anganwadi worker and the teachers towards improving the lives of the children in the village. The visit also gave the students an opportunity to interact with the children and understand their aspirations and challenges. The students left the village with a greater appreciation for the efforts being made towards improving education and healthcare in rural areas.

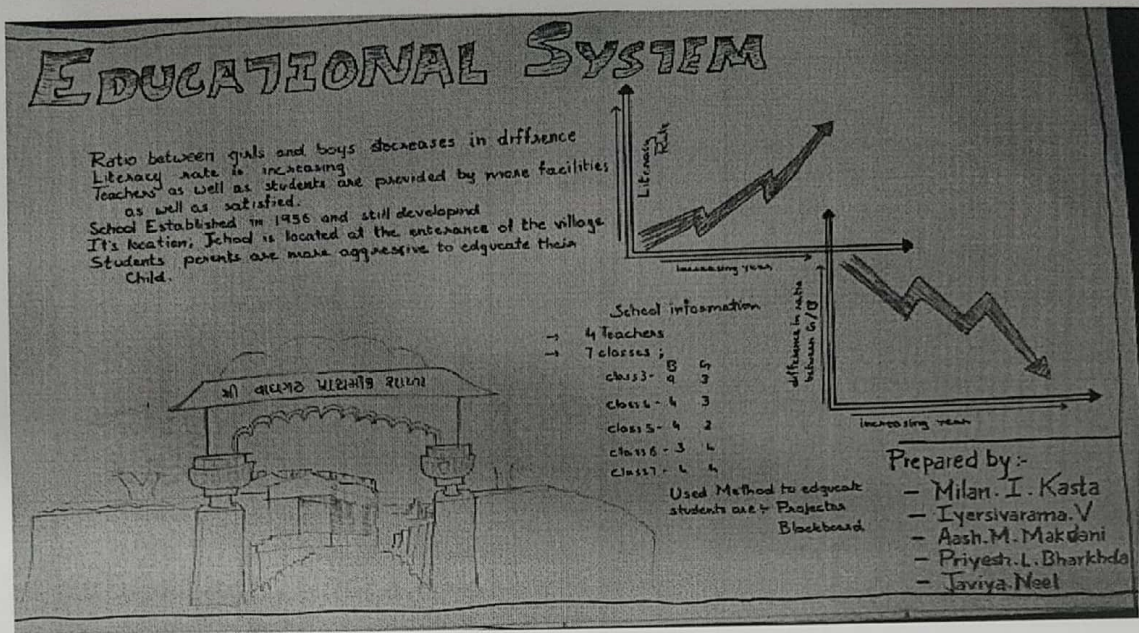
Village selected for the visit was Vaghagadh located near Tankara taluka, Rajkot, Gujarat.

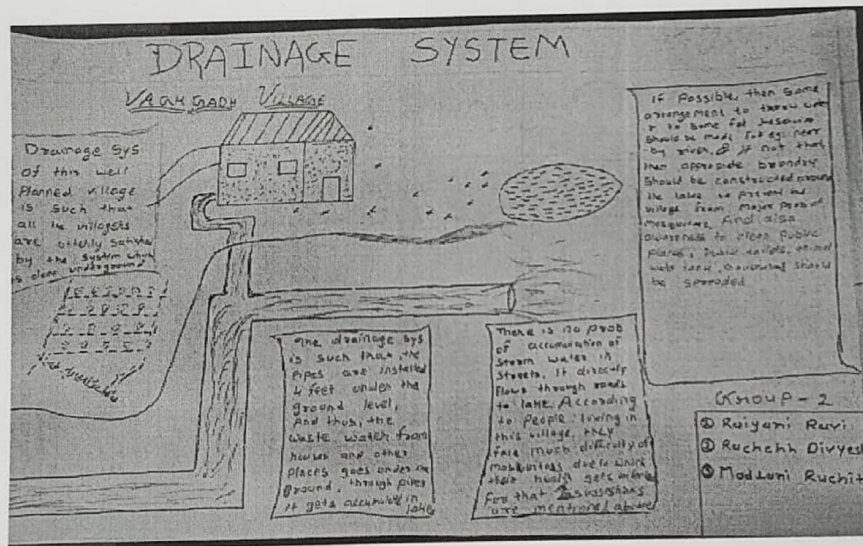

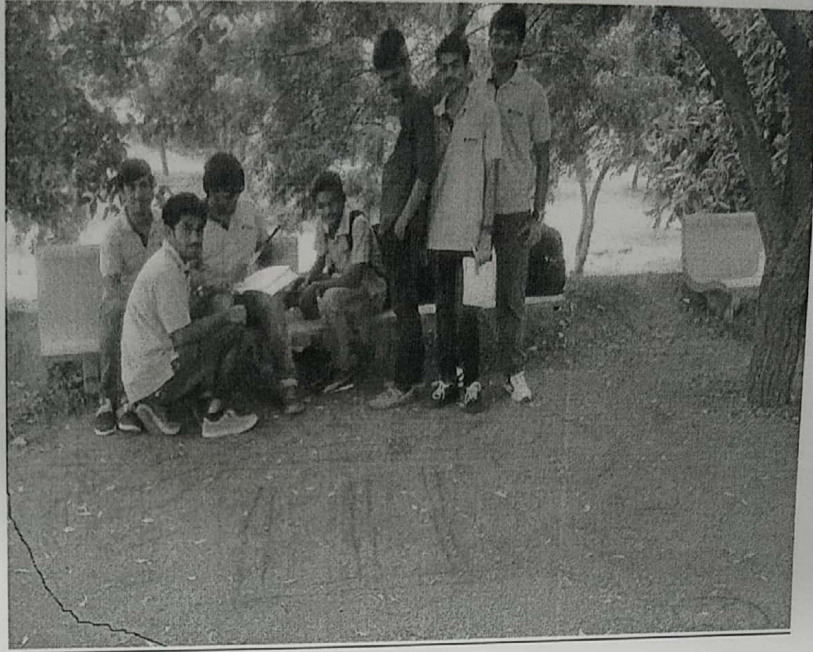

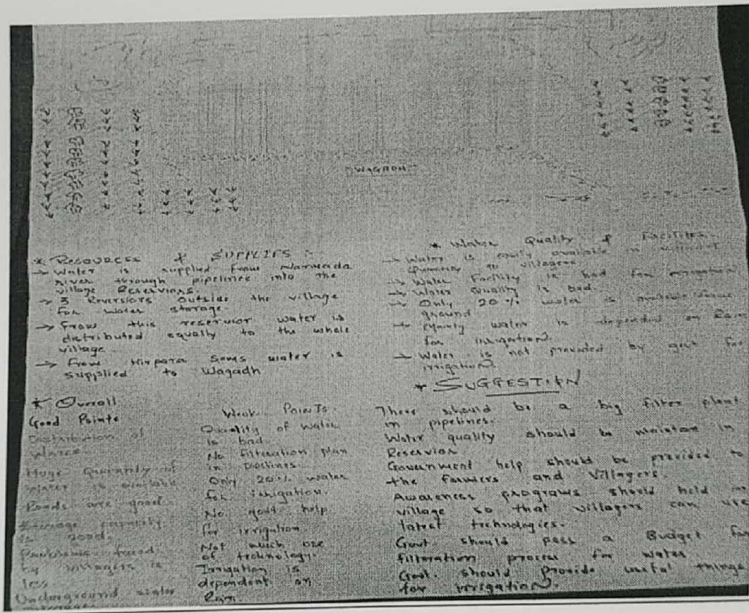
